




**Outer Base** 


Insert Cap




Hook & Handle / Height Gauge

### Installation


1 Cut the drainage pipe flush to the top of the floor. For timber floors reinforce the pipe with two button head screws to prevent retraction, this is not necessary in concrete. For 100mm pipe a reducer and sleeve is required. The reducer must be glued to its maximum depth.




100mm Pipe

Concrete Floor


Timber Floor




Prepare the floor area below the base ensuring it is level and flat. Position the outer base and ensure the outlet will be within the adjustment zone shown on the clear pan. Place some silicone between the floor and the internal corners before fixing the outer base to the floor with the masonry anchors or screws provided.




Prime the waste pipe and the adpator. Apply PVC cement (glue) to the pipe and adaptor. Insert the apaptor, place the supplied hook and handle on top of the adaptor to act as a height gauge then use the clear pan as a straight-edge to provide 17 mm of fall.




Drop in the clear pan. Push the pan down to the adaptor as you visually drill 2.5mm holes through the pan and the adaptor lugs, also drill a hole in the centre of the adaptor outlet. Keep pushing down, drill 2.5mm perimeter holes through the pan and collar in all four corners of the outer base. Note, when drilling the corner holes through the collar, slightly lean your drill inwards to ensure the screws will be seated square to the collar.





- Hook out the clear pan and expand all predrilled holes in the clear pan to 4.5mm. Enlarge the centre outlet hole with a 38mm hole saw. Remove all plastic shavings from the adaptor pan and collar where drilling has occurred.
- 6 Clean all adjoining surfaces that accept silicone with a clean cloth moistened with mineral turpentine then wipe with a clean dry cloth. Apply a <u>thick generous bead</u> of low modulus neutral cure silicone to the top of the adaptor and the collar of the outer base.



- Return the waste pan to align with the predrilled holes, push the pan down in the corners then push it down to the adapter. Hand-tighten all three adaptor screws alternating from one to the other until the pan rests on the adaptor. Firm the perimeter of the clear pan by pushing down around the perimeter. Hand-tighten corner screws until firm.
- **8** Place the insert into the outer base. Installation is complete.

#### Maintenance

- All Wydaflo products can be cleaned using a soft cloth and warm water, soap or a suitable household detergent. Always rinse off cleaners within five minutes of application. Never use a scouring cloth or other abrasive object to clean the product.
- If required, the insert cap can be removed using the supplied removal hook.
- If accidental scratches, abrasions or burns occur, the surface finish may be restored by gentle polishing with an emulsion based plastics cleaner.

#### Installation tips

- Use low modulus neutral cure premium grade sealants.
- Thoroughly clean adjoining surfaces that accept sealant.
- Apply sealant generously paying attention to the corners.
- When drilling into plastic use your drill on low speed.
- Tighten fixing screws by hand until the screws sit firm only.
